Welcome to Quick PDF Lite! This application is intended to allow you to view .pdf files on the iPad quickly, using a simple and straightforward interface. The application gives you the ability to view pdf files imported from iTunes or Mail.

Upgrade to Quick PDF+ for the following features:

- Support for Multiple File Formats including doc, xls, ppt and more
- Full Screen Views in Landscape and Portrait
- Jump to Page in PDFs
- Auto Saving of Current Scroll Position when exiting documents.

Quick PDF Instructions

Loading and Removing Documents on your iPad

In order to make the best use of this application, it's helpful to have documents to view. In order to load your documents onto your iPad, connect your iPad to iTunes. Your iPad should show up under "Devices".

After selecting your iPad, you should see tabs in the center window.

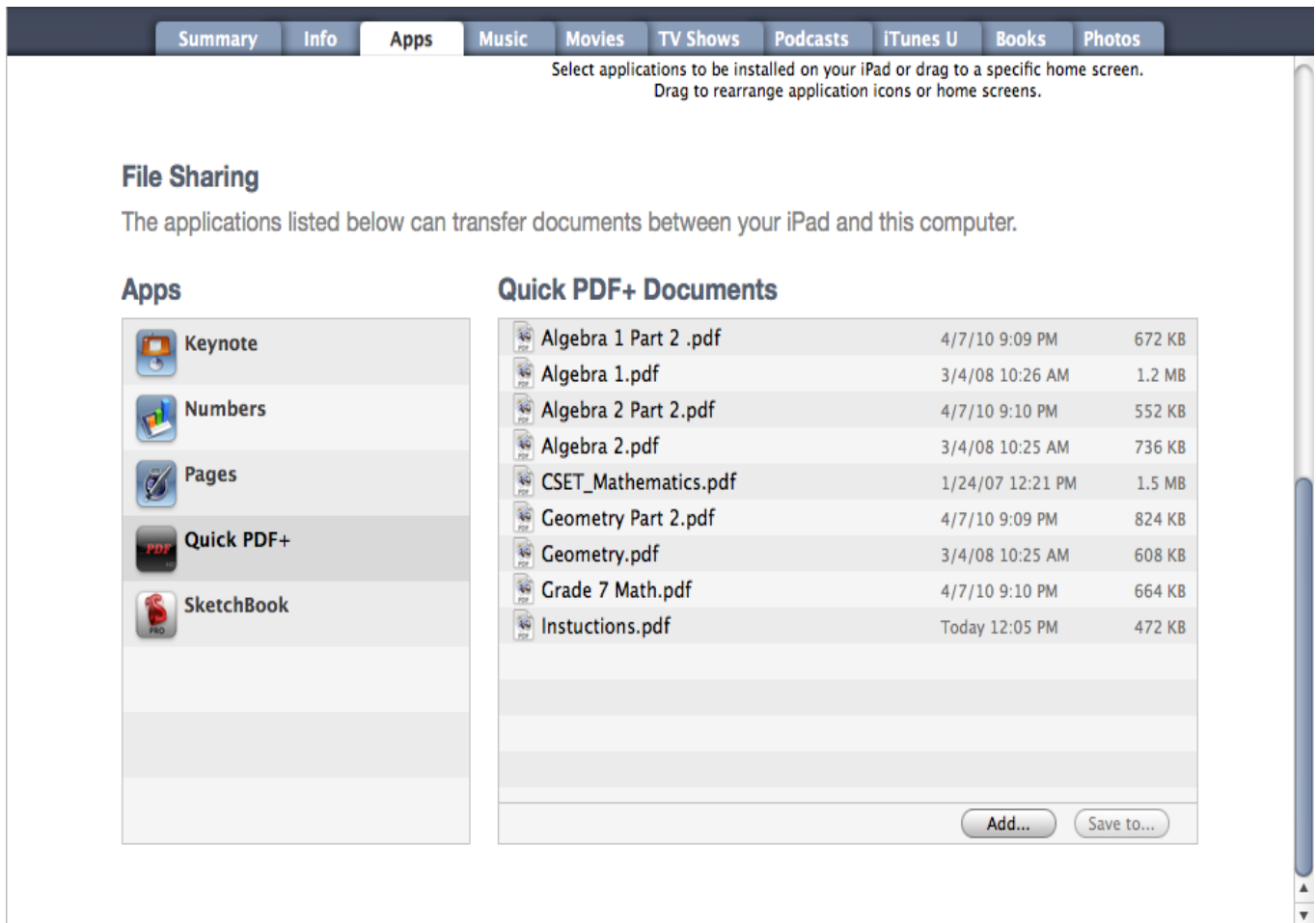
Click on the 'Apps' tab which is located right between the 'Info' and 'Music' tabs.

Scroll down to the bottom of your Apps page and you will see a file sharing section with all of your Apps listed that have the ability to load files.

Select Quick PDF Lite. Then select 'Add'

Once you have selected click the files you would like to view, you're all done. It may take a few seconds for your documents to sync, but they are usually updated quickly. You can tell if a file has already synced, because it will appear in black. Files that have not synced appear gray.

To remove unwanted files using iTunes, go to the the same place where you added the files to the add and click on the file and press the delete button on your keyboard and the file will no longer appear on your list of Documents. Be sure to press sync after removing a file to be sure that it is no longer on your iPad.

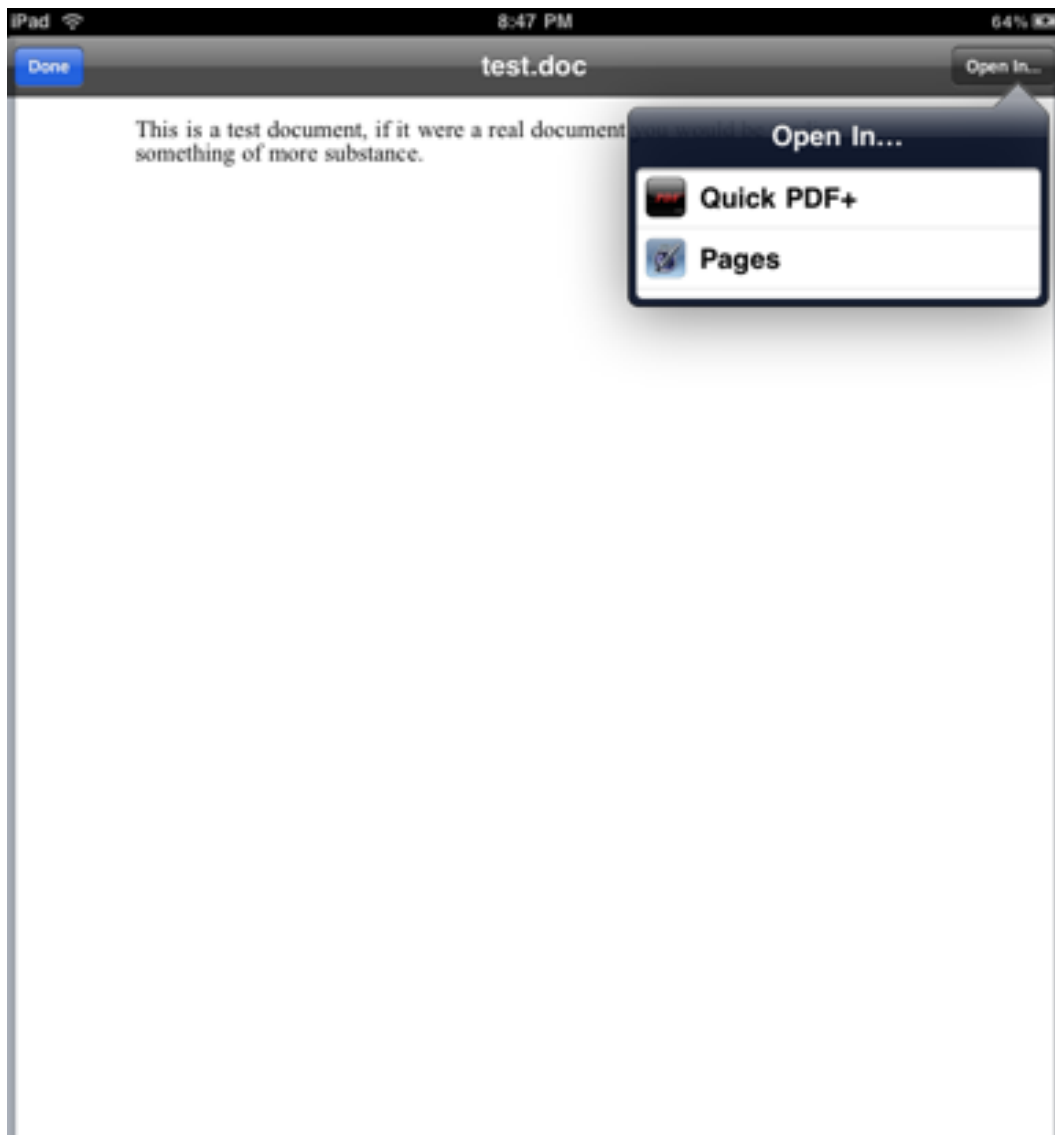


Using Quick PDF Lite Please read each section of the instructions to take full advantage of each of the features offered in Quick PDF Lite.

Landscape orientation allows you to see your available document files in a list on the left and a preview of those documents on the right. At the top of the files you will find a search bar that allows you to search for your desired file. The document files also have a tag on the left side signifying what kind of file it is.

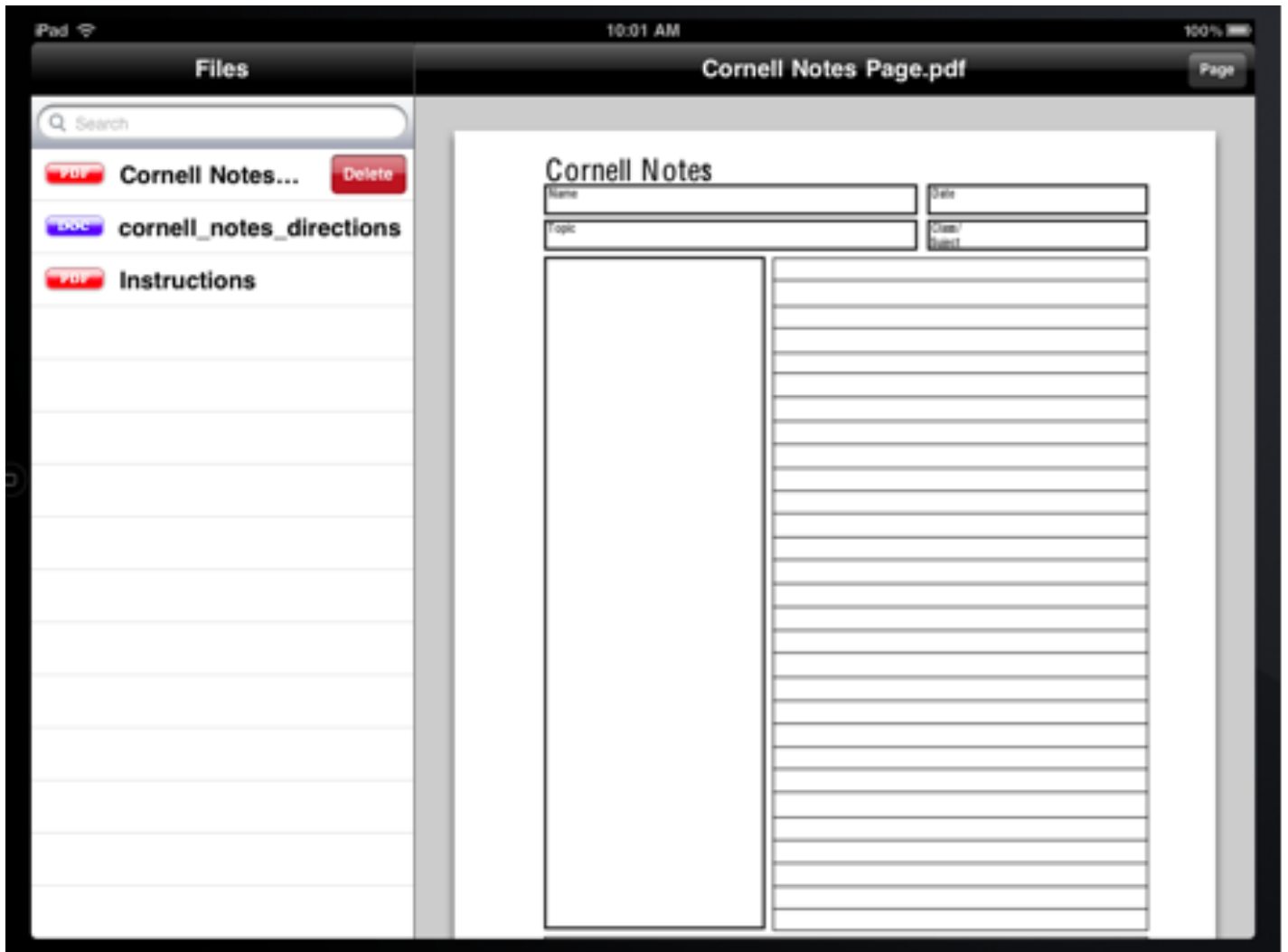
Portrait orientation allows you to see documents full screen. If you click file on the top left, then you will get the search bar and a list of your files just as you have in the split screen in the landscape orientation.

Opening Mail Attachments in Quick PDF Lite Quick PDF Lite can be used to open PDF mail attachments into the application. The process of opening a mail attachment is the same as it has always been in mail, except when you click to open the attachment in mail on your iPad device you will have a button on the top right hand side of the tool bar that states open in or open in Quick PDF that allows you to open the attachment in the application. Once you open the mail attachment in Quick PDF, your file is now saved in the application for further viewing.



Deleting Files in Quick PDF Lite

There are two ways you can delete files in Quick PDF Lite. The first is explained in the loading and removing documents on your iPad. The second way is in the application itself. You just swipe your finger from left to right across the name of the file in landscape view or from the 'Files' button in portrait, and a red delete button will appear. Press it and the file is gone.
